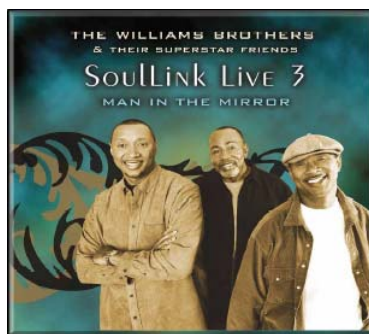
The Caravans are truly classy ladies who have created a great legacy and example for all who follow behind them.



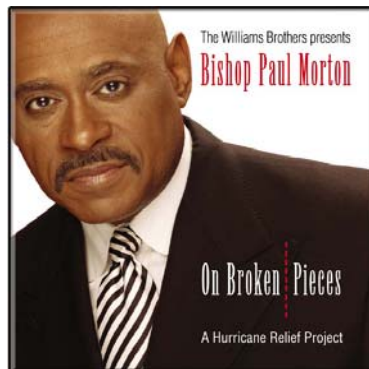

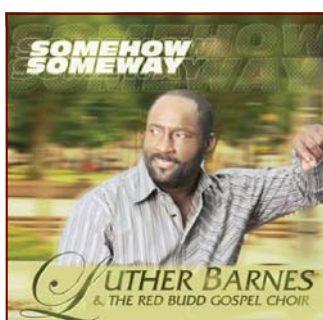
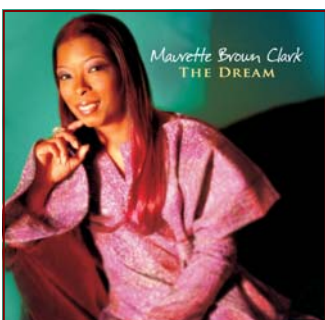
